Germany, officially the Federal Republic of Germany, is a sovereign state in Central Europe, bordered in the north by the North Sea, the Baltic Sea and Denmark, in the west by the Netherlands, Belgium, Luxembourg, and France, in the south by Switzerland, and Austria, and in the east by Czechia, and Poland. Additionally, Germany shares maritime borders with Sweden and the United Kingdom. Germany has an area of 357,022 km² making it the seventh largest country in Europe (if one includes Russia and Ukraine). In comparison, it is about two-thirds the size of France.

Germany is a manufacturing powerhouse



With the largest economy in Europe, Germany generates approximately 20% of Europe's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) and ranks fourth worldwide with a share of over 3% of global GDP. The country has a population of approx. 84 million people. One of the main reasons for economic Germany's success lies in its advanced capabilities in both manufacturing and services. Germany is currently one of the leading exporters in machinery vehicles and chemicals. Over the medium-to-long term, Germany is expected to shift away from exports and focus more on domestic consumption, caused by increased wages and a rising average age.




Foreign Direct Investment



- In 2023, SAR 14.7 billion in FDI stock were recorded (from Germany in Saudi Arabia), an increase by 15.6% compared to the previous year.
- In 2023, the value of the Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) Inflow was SAR 2.50 billion while the FDI Outflow reached a value of SAR 514.5 million. These amounts resulted in an FDI Net Inflow of SAR 2.0 billion, an increase of 158.0% than the previous year.






1st partners in GCC countries. UAE makes up 42.6% of Germany trade with GCC countries.

Saudi Arabia makes up 38% of GCC total trade with Germany



In 2024, Germany's exports to Saudi Arabia amounted to \$9.53 billion, accounting for 84% of the total trade between the two countries. The primary export categories included Machinery and mechanical appliances, boilers, nuclear reactors, Vehicles; other than railway or tramway rolling stock, and parts and accessories, pharmaceutical products, and Optical, photographic, cinematographic, measuring, checking, medical or surgical instruments and apparatus.

Germany's imports from Saudi Arabia totaled \$1.86 billion, representing 16% of the total bilateral trade. The key import categories were mineral fuels and oils, plastics and plastic articles, natural and cultured pearls, precious and semi-precious stones and organic chemicals.


Overall, Germany recorded a trade surplus of \$7.66 billion with Saudi Arabia in 2024, with total bilateral trade reaching \$11.39 billion.

Germany Imports from Saudi Arabia, in million US\$






Top trade categories between Germany & Saudi Arabia



In 2024, 65.7% of Germany's exports to Saudi Arabia were concentrated in five key categories. The largest export categories were Machinery and mechanical appliances, boilers, nuclear reactors (20.6%), followed by Vehicles; other than railway or tramway rolling stock, and parts and accessories (16.3%).

Meanwhile, 91.2% of Germany's imports from Saudi Arabia fell within five main categories. The dominant import categories were mineral fuels and oils (67.1%) and Plastics and articles (10.2%).

Top trade products between Germany & Saudi Arabia



In 2024, 40.7% of Germany's exports to Saudi Arabia were concentrated in ten key products. The top export items included motor cars and other vehicles, medicaments and aircraft.

Meanwhile, 88.5% of Germany's imports from Saudi Arabia were also concentrated in ten key products. The primary imports consisted of Petroleum oils and oils obtained from bituminous minerals; crude and Petroleum oils and oils from bituminous minerals, not crude and waste and scrap of precious metals.
